Background

With effect from 1 July 2004 all 108 contracting governments to the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) Safety of Life at Sea Convention (SOLAS) had to comply with the new IMO International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code. The Code sets out strict security requirements for all ports engaged in international maritime traffic. Failure to comply with the Code has already resulted in some ships being barred from entry into the ports of some countries.

This Course

The interactive five-day programme, designed for anybody with a legitimate interest or role in port security, introduces participants to the main requirements of the Code and, through case studies, lectures and syndicated exercises, sets out the steps that have to be taken in order for compliance. This course is based on the UK Government approved Port Facility Security Officer's Course but aimed at an international audience.
