This two week course focuses on how to select and specify physical (in particular electronic) security measures, how to conduct a vulnerability assessment, and how to survey. The course includes all necessary books and training materials.

In order to succeed on this programme, delegates should have at least a basic understanding of security technology, and have fast reading skills in English. In order to sit the examination, delegates will need to evidence six years of progressive physical security experience (four if they have a degree).

- Special Storage Areas (Safes and Vaults)
- Security of High-Rise Buildings
- Business Continuity Management

IMPORTANT – Applying for the PSP Certification Exam

The PSP examination is conducted by ASIS International and is computer-based at a number of Prometric test centres around the UK and globally. Prospective candidates are responsible for checking their eligibility to sit the examination and for registering direct with ASIS International in the United States as well as for booking their exam date direct with their preferred Prometric test centre location. **Applications to sit the examination, which costs \$300 for ASIS members and \$450 for non-members should be made direct to ASIS International via the ASIS website**
