Course Outcomes

- Identify the six key components common to most IEDs and list and describe the main types
- Explain the difference between high and low explosives
- Explain the behaviour of blast in relation to nearby structures
- Describe the main means of activating an IED
- Implement the key countermeasures with regard to a postal IED, hand-delivered IED, a large vehicle IED and an improvised incendiary device
- State the minimum evacuation distances for a variety of different IED scenarios
- Select, and manage the safe evacuation to, an appropriate assembly point
- Identify measures to mitigate against suicide vehicle attacks
