## Intended for:

Delegates undertaking the ARC university-accredited courses and studying towards the **MSc Professional Practice in Corporate Security Management**.

The objective is to ensure that each delegate, by the end of the course, has researched a security issue of direct relevance to his/her workplace, and, under instruction and coaching, has produced a 2,000-word academic essay to MSc standard.
